A bit about All Paul Together



Who is Paul

Paul Smith, happily married to Natasha for 17 years, is dad to two amazing and healthy children, Holly and James. He's a scientist, a sportsman, a true family man, and a great friend to many of us. On the 19th of April 2021 Paul's life was turned upside down when he was diagnosed with Motor Neurone Disease (MND).



MND

Motor Neurone Disease is a Neuro Degenerative Disease (NDD) which prevents the central nervous system from sending signals to motor neurones, which are critical to the movement and control of limbs. For 50% of sufferers, life expectancy from diagnosis is less than 3 years and the disease will gradually impact movement, speech, and the ability to breath unaided.



The Irish Motor Neurone Disease Association (IMNDA) is the only organisation of its kind in Ireland. They are dedicated to working on behalf of people living with MND and rely wholly on public donations. They have given – and continue to give – Paul tremendous support and advice since his diagnosis, which is why 25% of everything raised by *All Paul Together* will go directly to them.



GoFundMe is the fastest and safest way to fundraise for *All Paul Together*. Whether you're organising a huge sponsored walk with family and friends, or creating your own little virtual challenge, GoFundMe is simple to set-up, easy to share and a really good way of keeping track and thanking people for their donations.
